## Hearing notice - adjournment

**Terry James Minnie and Raymond Patrick Shaw**

**Section 161 of the *Securities Act*, RSBC 1996, c. 418**

- ¶ 1 The British Columbia Securities Commission is to determine whether it is in the public interest to make orders under the *Securities Act* against Terry James Minnie and Raymond Patrick Shaw. The hearing is set to start June 1, 2005.
- ¶ 2 On March 29, 2005, staff asked us to adjourn the hearing until a decision is issued in the criminal matter involving the respondents. It appears that the trial has been adjourned to October 17, 2005.
- ¶ 3 We remain of the view that it is in the public interest not to proceed with the hearing in this matter until staff conclude their investigation and a decision is issued in the criminal proceedings. The hearing is therefore adjourned until 10 am January 16 to 20, 2006 at the British Columbia Securities Commission, 12<sup>th</sup> floor, 701 West Georgia Street, Vancouver, British Columbia.
- ¶ 4 Temporary orders, issued on October 7, 2004 and extended on November 26, 2004, remain in effect until a hearing is held and a decision is rendered.
