- ¶ 1 The British Columbia Securities Commission is holding a hearing to determine whether it is in the public interest to make orders under the Act against Terry James Minnie and Raymond Patrick Shaw.
- ¶ 2 The Commission was to set dates for the hearing on February 22, 2006.
- ¶ 3 On February 20, 2006, the executive director applied to adjourn the set-date hearing.
- ¶ 4 We remain of the view that it is not in the public interest to hold the hearing in this matter until a decision is issued in related criminal proceedings. Those proceedings are scheduled to take place from September 11 to October 13, 2006. The hearing is therefore adjourned to 10 am on January 24, 2007 at the British Columbia Securities Commission, 12th floor, 701 West Georgia Street, Vancouver, British Columbia, when the Commission will set a date for the hearing.
- ¶ 5 Temporary orders, issued on October 7, 2004 and extended on November 26, 2004, remain in effect until a hearing is held and a decision is rendered.
