Hearing notice – adjournment and extension of temporary order

Section 161 of the *Securities Act*, RSBC 1996, c. 418

- ¶ 1 The British Columbia Securities Commission is to determine whether it is in the public interest to make orders under sections 161, 162 and 174 of the Act against the above respondents.
- ¶ 2 On November 1, 2006, the Executive Director issued a temporary order and notice of hearing against the respondents. The temporary order was set to expire on November 16, 2006.
- ¶ 3 On November 16, 2002, under section 161(3) of the Act, the Commission, considering it necessary and in the public interest, with the consent of the parties:
- extended the temporary order until December 14, 2006; and
 - adjourned the hearing to December 14, 2006 at 10 am at the British Columbia Securities Commission, 12th Floor, 701 West Georgia Street, Vancouver, when the Executive Director will bring an application to extend the temporary order and the Commission will set a date for the hearing.
