- ¶ 1 On February 6, 2014, the executive director issued:
 - a temporary order against SPYru Inc., Paradox Distributors (1992) Ltd., Echo Partners Ltd., U-GO Brands Nutritional Products Inc., Peter David Harris, Lorne Neil Cire, Christopher Andrew Burke, Millard Michael Kwasnek, Joseph Yvan JeanClaude Thibert a.k.a. John Thibert; and
 - a notice of hearing setting February 19, 2014 to hear the executive director's application to extend the temporary order until a hearing is held and a decision is rendered (2014 BCSECCOM 53).
- ¶ 2 On February 9, 2014, the respondents applied to the Commission to adjourn the executive director's application to extend the temporary order, and the executive director consented to the application.
- ¶ 3 On February 13, 2014, at the request of Thibert, the executive director varied the temporary order (2014 BCSECCOM 60) as follows:

"The Executive Director, considering the length of time to hold a hearing under section 161(2) of the Securities Act to be prejudicial to the public interest, orders under section 161(1)(b) and 161(1)(d) of the Securities Act that:

- (a) The Respondents cease trading in all securities, except Thibert may trade in accounts and and at Branch of control ; and
- (b) The Respondents be prohibited from engaging in investor relations activities."
- ¶ 4 The Commission, considering it necessary and in the public interest, and with the consent

of the parties, under section 161(3) of the Act extends the temporary order until March 13, 2014, and adjourns the hearing to extend the temporary order to March 13, 2014 at 10:00 am.
