#### How do I register to pay by Electronic Funds Transfer?

The following are the procedures on how to register for Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT):

- Print the following two forms from eServices:
  a. Payor Application Form
  b. Employee Authorization for Electronic Funds Transfer Form
- 2. Complete the forms
- 3. Send the completed forms to:

## What if the option to pay by Electronic Funds Transfer is not available?

You need to register for EFT prior to submitting an exempt distribution report. EFT will be set up within 24 hours.

You need to submit new forms with the updated information.
