How the BCSC handles enforcement Cases

Information Sources

Including the public, other agencies and internal sources

BCSC ENFORCEMENT

Case Intake and Assessment

Assesses information to determine if investigation is required.

Administrative Investigations

Investigates cases for breaches of the Securities Act.

Litigation

Prosecutes cases before BCSC Tribunal.

Tribunal

Holds a hearing and can order prohibitions or fines if it finds there has been misconduct.

Criminal Investigations

Investigates cases for criminal or quasi-criminal misconduct.

Crown Counsel

Prosecutes BCSC criminal and quasi-criminal cases in court.

BC Court

Holds a trial and can impose fines or jail if person found guilty.
