Correction

- [1] On May 23, 2023, the panel issued its Decision (2023 BCSECCOM 264) in this matter.
- [2] The panel corrects paragraph 1 of the Decision so that it reads as follows:
- [1] This is an application by an individual (Applicant) under section 171 of the *Securities Act*, RSBC 1996, c. 418 (Act). The Applicant requests that we consider whether the continuation of freeze orders (Freeze Orders) and registered charges (Charges) that are in place affecting the Applicant’s property is in the public interest, and make an order revoking or varying the Freeze Orders and Charges. The executive director opposes the application and submits that continuation is in the public interest.
- [3] The panel corrects paragraph 10 of the Decision so that it reads as follows:
- [10] Under section 1(1) of the Act, a “decision” in relation to the commission includes an “order... made under a power or right conferred by this Act or the regulations”. The Applicant seeks the revocation or variation of the Freeze Orders and Charges, and this application follows the executive director’s opposition to that request.
