Solicitation of Members for Corporate Finance Advisory Forum

The Commission is seeking expressions of interest from British Columbia securities market participants and other stakeholders who are interested in becoming members of the Commission's Corporate Finance Advisory Forum.

The Corporate Finance Advisory Forum advises the Commission's Corporate Finance staff on policy initiatives, capital market trends, and other emerging issues affecting reporting and non-reporting issuers, including investment funds. The Forum will

- foster continuing communication between Corporate Finance staff and market participants;
- provide information about the effectiveness of Corporate Finance initiatives; and
- keep staff up-to-date on current business practices and emerging trends as a means to support practical, efficient and cost-effective regulation.

We are looking for up to 25 members to serve for a three-year term. Participation will be a mix of in-person meetings and consultations by video conference or email depending on the issue or type of feedback sought. The time commitment will not generally be more than two hours each quarter.

The Corporate Finance division protects investors and fosters capital raising, including by: reviewing public offerings and continuous disclosure required to be prepared by issuers, including investment funds; monitoring exempt market activity; collaborating with Canada's other securities regulators in rule and policy development; monitoring insider reporting; responding to legal and regulatory issues arising in takeover bids and other transactions; and monitoring the development of accounting, auditing and ESG standards.

We encourage applications from issuer executives, investors and investor advocates, underwriters, lawyers, accountants, academics, geologists and other securities market participants.

We may conduct regulatory checks and a criminal record check of applicants, for the purposes of determining suitability for appointment to the Forum.
