**Filing BC Form 45-103F4 (Formerly Form 45-902F) By Facsimile**

Order under section 76 of the *Securities Act*

Where an issuer distributes a security and is required to file a BC Form 45-103F4 under section 139 of the *Securities Rules*, section 7.1 of Multilateral Instrument 45-103 *Capital Raising Exemptions*, or in accordance with the terms of an order made under section 76 of the *Securities Act*, the issuer is exempt from filing the original of a manually signed BC Form 45-103F4 provided that:

- a) the issuer files a copy of the manually signed BC Form 45-103F4 by facsimile with the British Columbia Securities Commission; and
- b) the issuer retains the original BC Form 45-103F4 that it has filed with the Commission under this instrument for a period of six years from the date of the filing.
