Solicitation of Members for new Corporate Finance Stakeholder Forum

The Commission is seeking expressions of interest from British Columbia securities market participants and other stakeholders who are interested in becoming members of the Commission's new Corporate Finance Stakeholder Forum.

The Corporate Finance Stakeholder Forum will advise the Commission's Corporate Finance staff on policy initiatives, capital market trends, and other emerging issues affecting reporting and non-reporting issuers, including investment funds. The Forum will

- foster continuing communication between Corporate Finance staff and stakeholders;
- advise on effectiveness of Corporate Finance initiatives; and
- keep staff up-to-date on market participant views, current business practices and emerging trends as a means to support practical, efficient and cost-effective regulation.

We are looking for up to 25 members to serve for a two-year renewable term. Participation will be a mix of in-person meetings and consultations by phone or email depending on the issue or type of feedback sought. We anticipate the time commitment will vary but will be no more than two hours each month.
