Take notice that the Appellants, Thalbinder Singh Poonian and Shailu Sharon Poonian, hereby apply for leave to appeal to the Court of Appeal for British Columbia from the decision of a hearing panel (the "Panel") of the British Columbia Securities Commission (the "Commission") pronounced on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2013 at Vancouver, British Columbia (the "Decision").

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the Court of Appeal will be moved at the hearing of this application for an order that:

- 1. leave to appeal the Decision be granted; and
- 2. if leave to appeal is granted:
  - a. an order that the Decision be set aside;
  - b. an order permanently staying the proceedings against the Appellants; and
  - c. an order that the Appellants be granted their costs of the appeal.

The grounds of appeal are that:

- 1. the Panel erred in law and exceeded its jurisdiction, or in the alternative, acted unreasonably, in admitting and relying on the letter of Len Doust, Q.C., external counsel for the Executive Director, dated September 12, 2013 (the "Letter") as evidence in the application;
- 2. the Panel erred in law and exceeded its jurisdiction, or in the alternative, acted unreasonably, in relying on the Letter for the truth of its contents;
- 3. the Panel erred in law and exceeded its jurisdiction, or in the alternative, acted unreasonably, in finding that the *ex parte* communication between representatives of the Executive Director and representatives of the Commission did not give rise to a reasonable apprehension of bias;
- 4. the Panel failed to consider and address the Appellants' submissions that they were denied procedural fairness and natural justice; and

5. such further grounds as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court may permit.

The hearing of this proceeding occupied 1 day.
