### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO APPEAL

Take notice that Justin Edgar Liu and Lukor Capital Corp. hereby apply for leave to appeal to the Court of Appeal for British Columbia from the decision of a hearing panel (the "Panel") of the British Columbia Securities Commission (the "Commission") pronounced the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2019, at Vancouver, British Columbia.

1.	The Panel's decision pronounced on September 10, 2019, with Reasons for Decisions dated September 12, 2019, indexed as 2019 BCSSECCOM 331 (the "Decision") be stayed pending the determination of this Appeal;			
2.	This application be heard at the same time as any other application(s) for leave to appeal the Panel's Decision;			

- 3. The Respondent/Non-Party Applicant Camp Fiornate Matthews Mogerman LLP be denied access to the affidavit exhibits #1 7 (the "Documents") filed in the Commission's proceedings for use in civil proceedings;
- 4. The appellants be given leave to adduce evidence for the purposes of this Appeal; and
- 5. Costs of this proceeding be awarded to the appellants.

## The grounds of appeal are:

- 1. The Panel erred in law in finding that the procedures for seeking and extending temporary orders, pursuant to Sections 161(2) and 161(3) of the Securities Act, constitute a "hearing" under Section 19 of the Securities Regulation and Section 7.5 of BC Policy 15-601 Hearings.
- 2. The Panel erred in law in concluding, when balancing the importance of the open court principle against the potential prejudice to the parties, that there is no fundamental difference between an interim proceeding and an enforcement hearing on the merits of the allegations made in a notice of hearing.
- 3. The Panel erred in law in its finding that the public duty exception to the Commission's obligation to keep information confidential, pursuant to Section 11(1) of the Securities Act, allows for the provision of information to third-parties for use in separate civil litigation proceedings.
- 4. The Panel erred in law by misapplying the implied undertaking rule by:
  - incorrectly concluding that the mere filing of the Documents in the Commission proceedings rendered the information public;
  - b. incorrectly concluding that absent a confidentiality order, the Documents should be made available to the public;
  - failing to recognize that the principles behind the implied undertaking rule may outweigh the open court principal in relation to information filed in an affidavit in interim proceedings as opposed to evidence tendered at an enforcement hearing on the merits;
  - d. failing to recognize that the nature of information in affidavits of Commission staff
    in support of an interim application in connection with an ongoing investigation
    differs from evidence vetted during an enforcement hearing that then becomes a
    part of the hearing record; and

- e. by granting the release of the Documents to Camp Fiorante Matthews Mogerman LLP for a collateral purpose outside the Commission proceedings for which it was produced.
- 5. Such other grounds as counsel may advise prior to the Hearing of the Leave to Appeal and this Court may permit.

The proceeding before the Commission proceeded by way of written submissions.
