- 1. leave to appeal be granted; and
- 2. if leave to appeal is granted:
  - an order that the order of the British Columbia Securities Commission ("Commission") pronounced the 8<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2013 be set aside; and
  - 2. an order that Perminder Sihota be granted her costs of the appeal.

The grounds of appeal are:

1. the Commission erred in law and exceeded its jurisdiction, or in the alternative, acted unreasonably, by making a temporary order pursuant to section 161(3) of the Securities Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 418 against

Perminder Sihota absent sufficient or any evidence that it was (a) necessary, and (b) in the public interest to do so;

- the Commission erred in law and exceeded its jurisdiction, or in the alternative, acted unreasonably, by exercising its statutory discretion to make the temporary order against Ms. Sihota for punitive reasons, contrary to the Commission's statutory mandate;
- 3. the Commission erred in principle by concluding that extending the temporary order against Ms. Sihota was (a) necessary, and (b) in the public interest; and
- 4. such further grounds as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court may permit.

The hearing of this proceeding occupied 1 day.
