CIBC has issued on December 15, 2009 the CIBC Short-Term USD/CAD Dual Currency Note maturing January 15, 2010 (the "Note"). The subscription price is USD 10,000,000 per Note. At maturity, the Investor will receive either (i) USD 10,000,000 per Note if the USD/CAD exchange rate is at or below 1.0933 on the Fixing Day plus interest on that amount in USD at a rate of 4.62% per annum, or (ii) CAD 10,933,000 per Note if the USD/CAD exchange rate is above 1.0933 on the Fixing Day plus interest on that amount in CAD at a rate of 4.62% per annum. The USD/CAD exchange rate as of December 14, 2009 was 1.0627. If the Investor receives CAD at maturity, the USD equivalent on the Fixing Day of CAD 10,933,000 will be less than the initial subscription price of USD 10,000,000 paid by the Investor. As such, an Investor's original USD investment is at risk, and an Investor may receive less than the original USD principal amount invested.
