And further take notice that the Court of Appeal will be moved at the hearing of this application for an order that:

1. Leave be granted to appeal the above-noted decision(s) as to liability and penalty, and a further order that the decision be stayed pending appeal;

2. Such other and further relief as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court grant.

The grounds of appeal are:

- 1. That the Commission erred, in law, in its interpretation and application of ss.168.1(1)(b), and 168.2 of the *Securities Act* in its ruling on liability on October 12th, 2018, incorporated as part of its decision pronounced April 9th, 2019;
- 2. That the Commission erred, in law, in violating s.173 of the *Securities Act*, and by breaching the Appellants' rights to natural and fundamental justice in denying the Appellants the opportunity to tender relevant and material evidence bearing on the issues before it;
- That the Commission erred, in law, by breaching the appellants" rights to natural and fundamental justice in denying the Appellants the right to full disclosure;
- 4. That the Commission erred, in law, by breaching the Appellants' rights to natural and fundamental justice by acting on perjured evidence;
- 5. That the Commission erred, in law, by breaching the Appellants' rights to natural and fundamental justice in denying the Appellants the consideration and treatment required, as set out by the Supreme Court of Canada, of self-represented parties;
- 6. That the Commission erred, in law, by breaching the Appellants' rights to natural and fundamental justice by its palatable errors in not giving regard to evidence, ignoring and suppressing evidence, and wholly misapprehending the evidence before it, relevant and material to the issues and findings by it;
- 7. Such further and other grounds as counsel may advance and this Honourable Court entertain.

The hearing of this proceeding occupied seven (7) days.
